

# University Area Reports Summary

## **Brown 1998**

This document is an M.A. thesis from the Department of Anthropology at the University of South Florida documenting homelessness in the University Area Community in the 1990s.

## **Community Safety Action Plan**

This plan outlines a comprehensive series of recommendations and action plans to improve community safety through housing and resident stability, disorder management, police efforts, business development, social service coordination and the built environment. The plan also identifies current observations on geography, demographics, reported crime, perceived crime, and an evaluation of past plans and studies to address community safety.

## **Cultural Resources Data Report**

This report documents cultural resources in the University Area Community.

## **EPA EJ Report for the UA**

This report highlights environmental indicators of environment justice in relation to demographic indicators in the University Area. The report also compares University Area trends to state and national trends.

## **GIS Analysis of Harvest Hope Park Area**

This analysis provides general and detailed data on aesthetic effects, air quality, contamination, economic, floodplains, historic and archeological sites, infrastructure, land use changes, mobility, navigation, noise, recreation areas, recreation potential, social data, special designations, water quality and quantity, wetlands and surface water, and wildlife and habitat, around Harvest Hope Park.

## **Gouldman 1994**

This document is an M.A. thesis from the Department of Anthropology at the University of South Florida documenting the 1992 Hillsborough County Planning and Development Management Department study of the University Area Community that aimed to address future development, recommendations for zoning, and current social problems.

## **Lewis 1996**

This document is a Ph.D. dissertation from the Department of Anthropology at the University of South Florida documenting the historical development of crime in the University Area Community.

### **MPO Innovation District Report**

The report identifies initial findings in existing conditions and transportation gaps in the Innovation District, including the University Area, and provides a summary of recommendations.

### **MPO Transit Circular Study**

This study precedes the MPO Innovation District Report, but similarly highlights current transportation gaps in the HART bus route and provides recommendations to improve the current system.

### **Phase I ESA – PAL site, 13704 N 20<sup>th</sup> St, Tampa**

This document is the Phase I Environmental Assessment of Harvest Hope Park. The report identifies key environmental indicators of the property potentially being labeled a brownfield. The report also includes historic information and maps of the property.

### **Planning Commission Poverty Maps**

This document contains a series of maps produced by the Hillsborough County Planning Commission identifying impoverished communities in Tampa from 1990 to 2014.

### **Sociocultural Data Report**

This report provides sociocultural data for the University Area specifically and Hillsborough County as a whole from 1990 to 2014. Domains identified include general population, race and ethnicity, age, income, disability, educational attainment, language, housing, and land use.

### **TIA Existing Conditions Study**

This study identifies demographic and economic conditions for the Innovation District of Tampa and provides suggestions for future planning initiatives in the area. The study also summarizes current plans within the Innovation District such as the University Area Community Plan.

### **UA 2012 Redevelopment Study**

This study focuses on population characteristics and rental housing market data in the University Area while providing redevelopment strategies.

### **UACDC 2015 Needs Assessment Final Results**

The report provides the final results of the 2015 UACDC Community Survey. The survey covered general demographics, education, employment, housing, health and well-being, crime and safety, and community.

### **UA Environmental Data**

This extensive report provides a map of the University Area and detailed information identifying every property in the area they may have a potential environmental impact.

### **UACDC 2016 Annual Report**

This report highlights the major programs supported by the UACDC such as Prodigy, Get Moving!, STEPS for Success, Partners Coalition, and Harvest Hope Park. The report also identifies how each program has successfully improved the lives of community members.

### **UACDC Block Model Development Report**

Block-by-block is a new UACDC initiative to provide community residents and families around Harvest Hope Park with custom resource packages based on identified needs. The document provides a timeline on how each participating family is served by identifying needs and providing customized case files of resources to address the identified needs. The document also provides a map of targeted community residents for the program around Harvest Hope Park.

### **Walkability Questionnaire**

In 2016 the UACDC conducted a walkability survey with residents to evaluate challenges to community members in walking around the University Area. This document is the survey used with community members for this study.
